- Be aware of extensions to BFR's and Medicals (as per CASA)
- Check aircraft are airworthy before flying after a prolonged break.
- Check there are no insects or birds blocking vents.
- Check for any changes in airspace requirements.

The main thing is not to be complacent.

John advised that the Paul Bennett Air Show will be live streamed via the RAAus website on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> June for members for free.

Phil advised that the Visual Flight Rules have been updated. Check for updates.
