<u>Opening</u> The meeting opened at 9.58am and Kelvin spoke about the purpose of the meeting, summed up the previous Christmas Party and tabled a list of possible events for the year as suggested by himself and others:

- Round trip 3-4 days Roma. Charleville (Cunnamulla), Cameron Baker (remote property visit)
- AGM/Social + BBQ 30th July (this was updated to 23rd July due to Jumpers and Jazz). 22nd July brunch (allows members to fly in). This was also updated to 24th or 30th July for J&J.
- 2023 Planning Day mid-November+ BBQ 19th November '22
- 2022 Christmas Party 3rd December '22

Kelvin suggested a Southern trip in March and a Northern trip in August.

A Broken Hill trip would possibly take 7 – 10 days.

- John Reid said a Murray River trip could take two weeks. The New Zealand trip is off. John and Wal will get some dates (check school holidays).
